Meeting was called to order at approximately 6:35 PM, with a quorum present. The meeting began with a moment of silence to reflect on the One Wall Love on Leonidas which was recently torn down. Minutes were approved and Nathan Schwam, treasurer, reported \$3250.12 in the account.

CM Joe Giarrusso (District A) Updates regarding:

Joe spoke about several issues including:

- conditional use legislation,
- permitting notice rules to neighbors,
- the D2D issues – a September 21 call with neighbors to discuss potential solutions to that concern.
- The city will grant additional monies to the HANO/IRIS development to add back doors.
- Still following developments with Don’s Grocery, shootings and drug deals
- SWBNO is considering leveled billing
- Truck issues – an annual report is to be done from now on by DPW

Candidates – Two candidates spoke: David Alvarez, School Board and Elroy James, Judge

Stephen Mosgrove – Liaison Mayor’s Office of Neighborhood Engagement Updates regarding:

- Census - Reminding everybody to remind everyone to fill out their census
 - Please continue to encourage others to respond to the 2020 census it is a critical need for the city & state.
 - Deadline changed to September 30, 2020 to respond to the census – Federal Government shortened the deadline by a month.
- Road Work – contact Dawn Massey for questions.

Announcements and Updates:

- **Lycee Francais School** – Marina Schoen announced that renovations on Priestly have begun., with about a 14 month construction schedule. We are invited to a September 16 meeting with the Project Manager.
- **Oak Street Demolition** – 8217 Oak has been demolished due to “public safety” concerns, i.e. termite ridden. Many feel it is demolition due to neglect. An attempt has been made to contact owners, with no response.
- **Carrollton Courthouse.** Announced that construction should commence soon.
- **Housing/Zoning**
- Neighborhood residents who have been working to improve the HANO/IRIS development have been accused of not wanting affordable housing and/or being racist.
- **School Board Forum** – A forum with school board candidates will be held the week of October 12th.
